God “Telegraphs” What He’s Up To

Joseph/Jesus

- The favored son of his father
- His father sent him to his brothers who rejected him
- Robes taken from him
- Taken to Egypt to avoid being killed
- Sold for the price of a slave
- Tempted
- Falsely accused
- Condemned between two prisoners
- 30 years old at beginning of recognition
- Forgave those who wronged him
- His suffering eventually led him to a place of prominence and honor
- His suffering was to save the lives of those he loved
- His brothers bowed their knees to him at last

Moses/Jesus

- Called from a distant land
- Called to true heritage
- 400 years of silence precedes arrival
- Survived infanticide
- 40 days
- Prince of Egypt, Prince of Peace
- Rejected
- Delivered from bondage
- Series of miracles led up to final salvation
- Final victory: death of firstborn/one and only Son
- Victory over tormentors: Egypt & Satan
- Passover—blood on doorpost
- Even after deliverance, doubt, fear, rebellion, effects of sin still linger
